What is "mixed paper"?




■The following are considered mixed paper (recyclables):

Candy boxes, posters, paper bags, notepad paper, chopstick sleeves, copy paper (excluding thermosensitive paper), postcards, toilet paper cores, wrapping paper, inserts for clothing such as dress shirts, envelopes (no address stickers, remove cellophane from windowed envelopes)


Disposing of newspapers, magazines, cardboard boxes, and crumpled paper



OBind each group of items with string vertically in both directions

Non-recyclable papers



The following are considered burnable garbage: Paper that has been treated with wax (including envelopes with attached adhesives, plastic-coated paper, or paper drinking wurnable garbage cups), aluminum-coated paper, photographs, thermal paper, carbon paper, and the like

Waste cloth

∴ Cancelled in case of rair

Includes

Generally, "waste cloth" is old clothing. Ensure the cloth is washed before being put out. (There is no need to remove buttons, etc.)

■Examples of old cloth (a typical example. Certain materials may not be eligible for recycling.)

T-shirts, dress shirts, pants, sweaters, skirts, sheets, underwear (articles without sanitary issues), towels, blankets, handkerchiefs, sweat suits

*Please do not dispose of wet, torn, or extremely dirty items or items with a strong odor as waste cloth.



Disposal procedure

1 Wash the

2Place them in recyclable

3Take the garbage to the recyclable collection site

Place your bagged recyclables and garbage out at the collection point by 8:30 on the designated

- ★Submit your payments promptly! Avoid missed payments by setting up direct debit payments from your bank account.
- ★If your payment is late ... If payment is late you will be sent a notification by the City Hall. Notices are also sent to person paying in payments. If you are paying in payments, continue to do so.

You may be contacted by an employee of the city by phone to give you instructions. You may have a sound reason for your delayed payment, but the Tax Office will not know this if you do not consult with or contact us. Please notify us of any special circumstances.

If you are too busy during the day on weekdays to make your payment...

- 1 The main building's second floor will be open to answer tax-payment related questions and accept payments.

- 2 Tax payments will be accepted at the Komaki Station branch office every day. Please stop by at your convenience.
- You may pay your taxes at a local convenience store if your payment slip has a barcode. *Only effective during the indicated payment period.



A subsidy is available for adult rubella vaccination. The subsidy is available until March 31, 2014.



1 Eligibility *************************

For persons determined by a doctor to require the vaccine based on a low test result for resistance to rubella, on the day they receive the vaccination they are registered as residing in Komaki and meet one of the following criteria:

- Women planning to or desiring to get pregnant; or
- 2 The husband of such a woman (Includes men living together in a marital-like relationship that have not registered their marriage).
- 3 Husbands of pregnant women (Includes men living together in a marital-like relationship that have not registered their marriage). %Pregnant women are unable to receive the vaccine.

- *Be aware that for this period, the tax office will accept submission of declaration forms but will not prepare them.

Persons with income from wages not adjusted before year end: Persons with wages from 2 or more sources




- ★Income deductions certificate (Gensenchoshuhyo) (Original copy)
- ★Documents certifying social insurance premiums
- ★Documentation certifying payment of life insurance and earthquake insurance premiums
- ★Medical expense receipts
- ★Personal seal
- *Other documentation may be required depending on the content of your declaration. If unsure, contact the Komaki Tax Office.

You can prepare your tax declaration without going to the tax office on your home PC. You can prepare declaration forms for income tax related final tax declaration, blue form declaration calculation sheet, accounting sheet, consumption tax declaration form and gift taxes at the Final Tax Declaration Form Preparation Corner. * Nation Pension for all persons from 20 years old *

National Pension is a system to provide a common basic pension to all citizens to ensure livelihood after becoming elderly or in case of sickness. In order to provide this service all persons living in Japan between ages 20 and 60 are required to pay national pension premiums (basic pension) regardless of occupation.

On your 20th birthday, an application form will be sent by the Nagoya North Branch Office; ensure completion of the application procedure. If you are unable to pay premiums, persons under 30 years of age or students can use a reduction or exemption system. Please contact us for more details.
