Consumption taxes for water and sewage measured in June will be 8%

The consumption tax rate was raised to 8% on April 1, 2014. The amount of the bill in June excluding the amount used in March and earlier will include consumption tax of 8%.

The allotted charges (or temporary fees for newly installed waterworks) shall be the fee with 8% consumption tax from April 1.

Provision of Temporary Child-Raising Household Special Benefit and Child Raising Support Tax Reduction Allowance will start in July.

Households eligible to receive the Temporary Child-Raising Household Special Benefit and Child Raising Support Tax Reduction Allowance will be sent application forms from the City. Fill in required information and submit within the period. You will not be able to receive the benefits unless you submit the documents.

[Eligibility] Application is limited to recipients of childcare allowance for January 2014.

[Amount of Support] ... 10,000 yen will be provided for each child eligible for child allowance as of January 2014.

[Application period] ... July 1 (Tue) 2014 to January 5 (Mon) 2015

[Where to Apply]....... Apply to the municipality of registered domicile as of January 1, 2014.

Unable to pay National Pension Premiums? Please consult with us!

If your household has low income, you may apply to have your national health insurance premiums lowered. (This is called an application for exemption.) In particular, persons up to 29 years of age can apply with only their income at the Health Insurance and Pension Department.

- ☆You can apply back for up to 25-months-worth
 - *Persons that have applied for exemptions or deferrals in the past that were approved must apply for renewal each year after July.



What about National Pension?

The laws of Japan specify that foreign nationals living in Japan aged 20 to 59 must enroll in national pension and pay the premiums. There are three kinds of national pension.

Basic pension for the elderly

People that have paid national pension premiums for at least 25 years (or had approved exemptions) can apply to receive benefits from 65 years old.

Basic disability pension

During enrollment in national pension, persons determined to have a level 1 or 2 disability due to sickness or injury can receive benefits upon approval of their application.

Basic survivor pension

Survivors of persons that die during enrollment in national pension can receive benefits upon approval of their application.

****Lump sum** withdrawal

Foreign nationals that have paid 6 months or more worth of national pension premiums may apply for a lump sum withdrawal within two years of leaving Japan. Please apply at City Hall before leaving Japan. You will be provided with an application form.
