OMunicipal and prefectural taxes (4th term) ONational Health Insurance Tax (8th term) ONursing Care insurance (7th term) OLate-Term Medical Insurance for the Elderly (6th term)

Submit your payments promptly! Smooth functioning of the system requires that everyone make timely payments. Avoid missed payments by setting up direct debit payments from your bank account. If you have already set up direct debit payments for your taxes, be sure that your account has sufficient funds available by the day before payment is due.

- The City Hall Income Tax Office will be open on the following Sundays to answer tax-related questions and accept payments. ODates / Jan 9 and 23 (Sundays) 8:30–17:15
- 2. Tax payments will be accepted at the Komaki Station branch office every day. Please stop by at your convenience. OBusiness hours from 8:30–17:15. OThe Komaki Station branch office is closed during the New Year holidays.
- 3. If your payment slip has a barcode, you may pay your taxes at a local convenience store.
