Year-end/New Years garbage and recycling

Thank you for your cooperation in the separation of garbage and recyclables. There are many people that will dispose of a larger amount of waste during year-end and new year house cleaning. Here are the answers to some common questions regarding garbage collection at this time of year.



Will garbage be collected during the year-end/New Years season?



▶ Garbage will not be collected from Dec 31 (Mon) to Jan 3 (Thu).

What is the last day of the year garbage will be collected? What is the first day of the new year garbage will be collected?

The precise date varies depending on where you live. Make sure to check your Recycling/Garbage Collection Calendar and place your garbage out by 8:30 a.m. on the appropriate day. Recycling/Garbage Collection Calendars are available if you don't have one at the City Hall, Civic Centers and Municipal Center.

Where can I take garbage if I want to dispose of some? What can I bring? When can I go?



Garbage and recyclables must be brought to different locations if you will bring it there yourself.

%Follow the instructions for disposing of garbage and recyclables, sort them, and bring them to the disposal site.

How do I dispose of bulky garbage?



Bulky garbage is handled by one of the following methods:

- ODisposal of bulky garbage can be applied for by calling the Reception Center with a fee of 1,000 yen. TEL0120-530-415
- ●Hours: 9:00 to 17:00 (except weekends, holidays and the New Year holidays)
- ■Up to 5 items are accepted at a time.
- Period: Collected on the day of the week for plastic containers

Please make a reservation between one month and one week before you want the items to be collected.

The payment deadline is the 25th (Tue). Submit your payments promptly! Automatic withdrawal from your account is recommended as an easy way to not forget to make your payments.

If you have already set up direct debit payments for your taxes, be sure that your account has sufficient funds available by the day before payment is due.

©Between Dec 3 (Mon) and Dec 25 (Tue), taxes that have not been paid shall be collected. During this period city employees will visit homes to collect the money. City employees have identification (tax collector certificate). Be sure to check the identification.

Start of inactive polio vaccination, quadruple vaccine, and influenza vaccine for seniors

• From November 1, 2012 we started offering quadruple vaccine which replaces the inactive polio and DTP vaccines. Children born from August 2012 will be sent an examination card in order about 3 months after birth. Children born before that date that have not received the previous inoculations can trade their examination card at the Health Center if they wish for the new quadruple vaccine.

If the child has received either the polio or DTP vaccine, they may not switch partway to the quadruple vaccine.


The City will also not retweet or follow other users.

Overview of the account settlement for fiscal 2011



The general budget handles expenses except for special accounts, the annual revenue settled accounts for the general budget of fiscal 2011 was 52,463,850,000 yen, an increase of 4,066,340,000 yen or 8.4% over the previous year. The general accounts expenditures amounted 49,540,560,000 yen or an increase of 4,263,020,000 yen or 9.4% over the previous year.

The settled general account expenditures equal 323,068 yen per capita when divided by the number of citizens. In the same way, settled general account revenues consist of roughly 60% city taxes, divided by the number of citizens is 198,898 yen per capita.
