

# Preparing for Fire



# **House Fire Prevention**

It is important to prevent fires daily.

Measures

Habbits

Check the 7 points below and be diligent for fire prevention.

House Fire Prevention **7 points** to save your life.

1 Install smoke detectors to prevent the delay of evacuation.

2 Use fire-proofed items to prevent the fire from beddings, clothes and curtains.

4 Organize a cooperating system in your neighborhood

to protect elders and physically handicapped people.

5 Never smoke in bed. .... 6 Use heaters away from burnable items.

7 Always turn off gas stoves when leaving.



How to use electrical appliances and daily guideline.

- 1 Do not overload an electrical circuit. (See the picture on right)
- 2 Do not pull the cord forcibly to disconnect a plug.
- 3 Disconnect a plug from the outlet when it is not used.
- **4** Clean the plug regularly to prevent tracking phenomenon. (remove dust and rust)

### Install smoke detectors in houses.

Due to the recent increase of fatalities caused by residential fires, installation of smoke detectors in houses, apartments and condominiums is urged by law.

### Required places to install.

Bed room: Install in rooms that are slept in.

Staircase: Install at staircases connected to floors

where bed rooms are.

OKitchen: Recommended, but not required.

Detects heat and smoke caused by a fire and notifies of the outbreak of a

fire by buzzer or recorded voice.

### Beware of clothes catching on fire!

Beware of your clothes cathching on fire.

It is a common fire accident, and some casualties have occurred in Komaki City as well.

If the clothes you are wearing caught on fire, roll on the ground to extinguish the fire. In case you find drawn water such as in bath tub, throw water to extinguish the fire. 

\*The fire victim must go to see a doctor at medical institution after the fire is extinguished.

### Guide to actions when fire breaks out.

In case fire breaks out, remain calm and practice the 3 steps described below.

First-aid fire fighting

• Report as soon as possible

OShout "Fire" as loud as possible and tell the neighbors.

○Call 119.

**Extinguish** the fire

Report

2 Extinguish as soon as possible

OExtinguish the fire carefully use the fire extinguisher.

Evacuation

3 Evacuate as soon as possible

OIn case of interior fire, stop fighting the fire and run away if the fire reaches to the ceiling.

Ocover your mouth and nose, and keep your self as low as possible when evacuating in the smoke.



Use the fire extinguishers on the street.

Public fire extinguishers are set on the streets except for around condominiums and apartments, for first-aid fire fighting use.


