

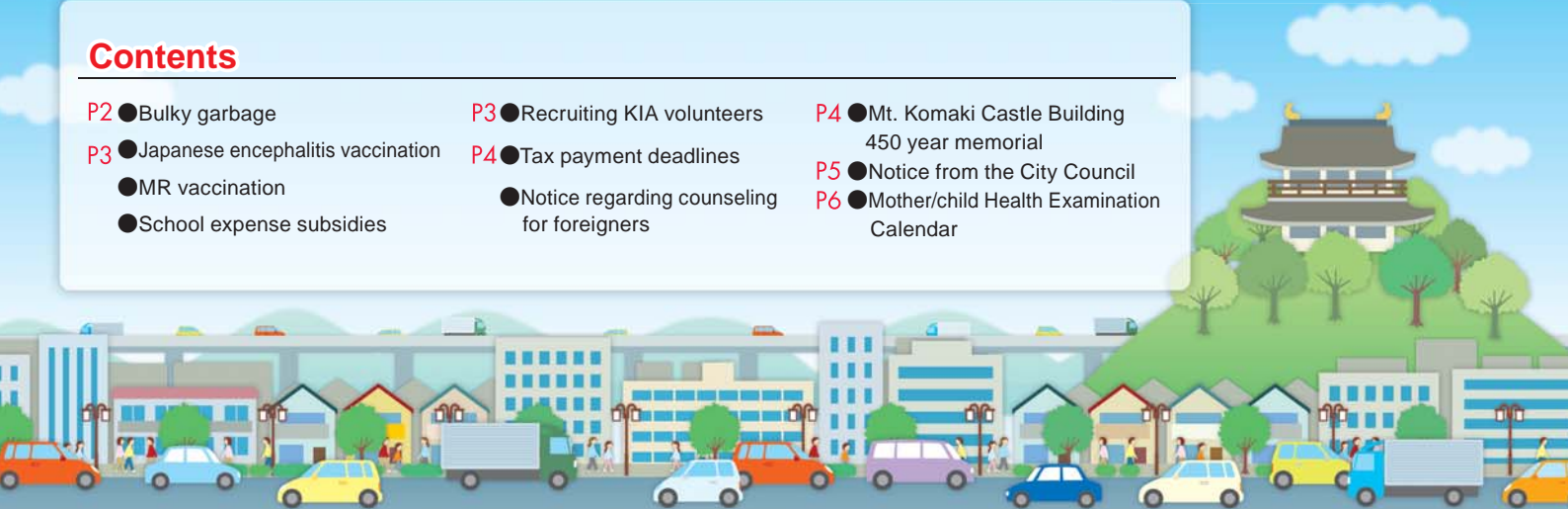

Bulky Garbage

Sorting/setting out recyclables and garbage

Includes

Items exceeding 60cm in any dimension will be considered bulky garbage.



Not included

Any of the following, even if larger than 60cm, cannot be disposed of as bulky garbage.

- Items covered by the home appliance recycling law (air conditioners, washing machines, TVs, fridges, freezers, clothes driers)
- Computers

Disposing of bulky garbage

Bulky garbage is handled by one of the following methods:

① Paid individual collection

Please call the bulky garbage reception center to make a reservation.

Free Dial 0120-530-415 (cellphone enabled) Hours: 9:00 to 17:00 (except weekends, holidays and the New Year holidays)

- Up to 5 items are accepted at a time.
- Please make a reservation between one month and one week before you want the trash to be picked up.

① Please tell the center the number, size and kind of bulky items with your name, address and telephone number.

The center will let you know the collection date, the place to put the bulky garbage, and your reception number.

② Purchase a Komaki bulky garbage disposal fee ticket (sticker) at a retailer.

- The ticket (sticker) is sold at major supermarkets, convenience stores, shops and so on.
- Purchase the ticket (sticker) only after making a reservation. (Tickets are non-refundable)
- Affix the ticket (sticker) so that it can be seen easily.

③ Please place the garbage at the location indicated by the operator by 8:30am on the day of collection.

- Collection does not require your attendance.

Changing or canceling a reservation

- At least one week before the collection date
→ Bulky garbage reception center (0120-530-415)
- Less than one week before the collection date
→ Recycle House (78-3631)



Required information

Please tell the center the number, size and kind of bulky items with your name, address and telephone number.



Provided information

The center will let you know the collection date, the place to put the bulky garbage, and your reception number, as well as the fee and how to pay it.

② Bringing waste

Garbage may be brought directly to KOMAKI IWAKURA Sanitation Union Center.

Japanese encephalitis vaccinations

The vaccination period has been extended. Please check your Maternal and Child Health Handbook. We recommend completing the first series of vaccinations (three injections) at your earliest convenience if you have not completed it already. If you do not have an examination card, please contact the Health Center.

Eligibility Children born between June 1, 1995 and April 1, 2007

Vaccination period Until 20 years old

Injections First series initial injections: 2 First series addition injection: 1
Second series (from 9 years old): 1 Total: 4 injections



Regarding MR vaccination

(second, third and fourth series of injections)

Measles is a highly infectious disease that spreads rapidly to those that do not receive vaccination. Rubella causes major medical issues when caught as an adult. Please have your children receive their second injection to make sure they are vaccinated. Those eligible were sent an examination card in May. If you do not have an examination card, please contact the Health Center.

Eligibility 2nd series: Born between April 2, 2006 and April 1, 2007
3rd series: Born between April 2, 1999 and April 1, 2000
4th series: Born between April 2, 1994 and April 1, 1995
(3rd and 4th series will no longer be offered after this year.)

Vaccination period March 31 (Sun) 2013
※Please go to a local implementing medical facility to receive the injection when you feel well.

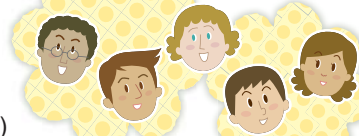

Tax payment slips for the new fiscal year will be sent out in April. If you have not yet paid your taxes, please make your payment as soon as possible. You may have a sound reason for your delayed payment, but the Tax Office will not know this if you do not consult with or contact us. Please notify us of any special circumstances.

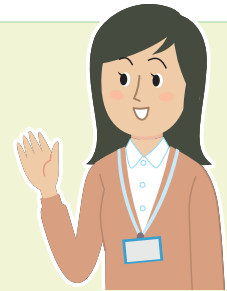
If you are too busy during the day on weekdays to make your payment...

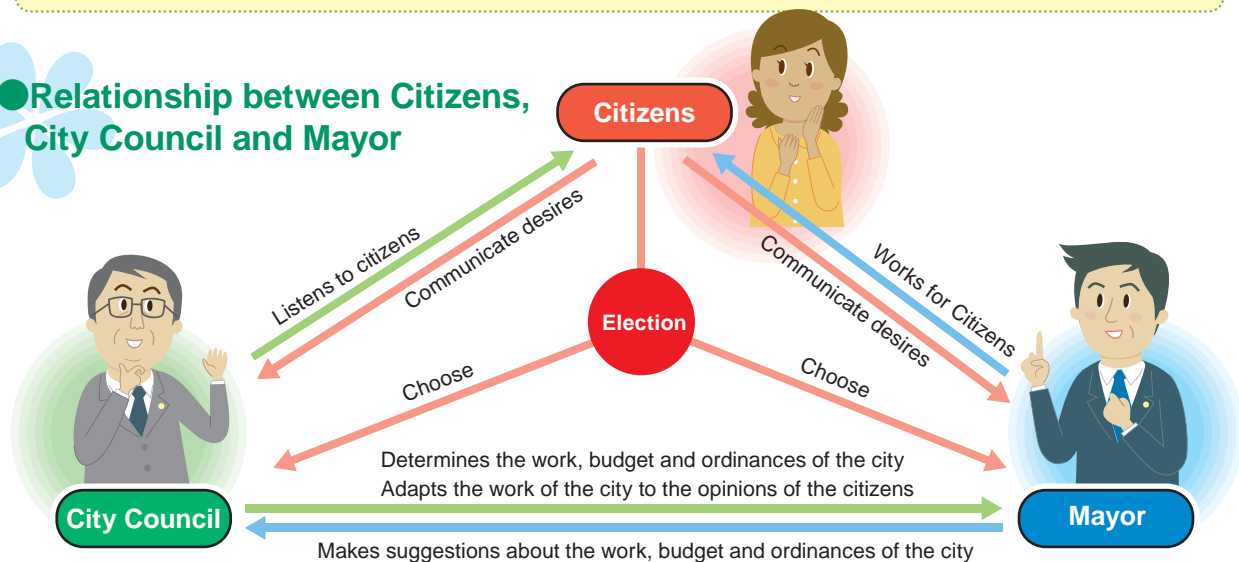


●Role of the City Council

Role of the City Council

- ★Determines and revises the rules (ordinances) of the city.
- ★Determines how to use municipal monies (the budget).
- ★Verifies that municipal monies (the budget) and the work of the city are being performed properly.
- ★Submits opinions to the national and prefectural administrations.
- ★Almost every part of this work directly impacts the quality of life of citizens so one is able to present opinions to the City Council through the Councilors if a change is desired.
