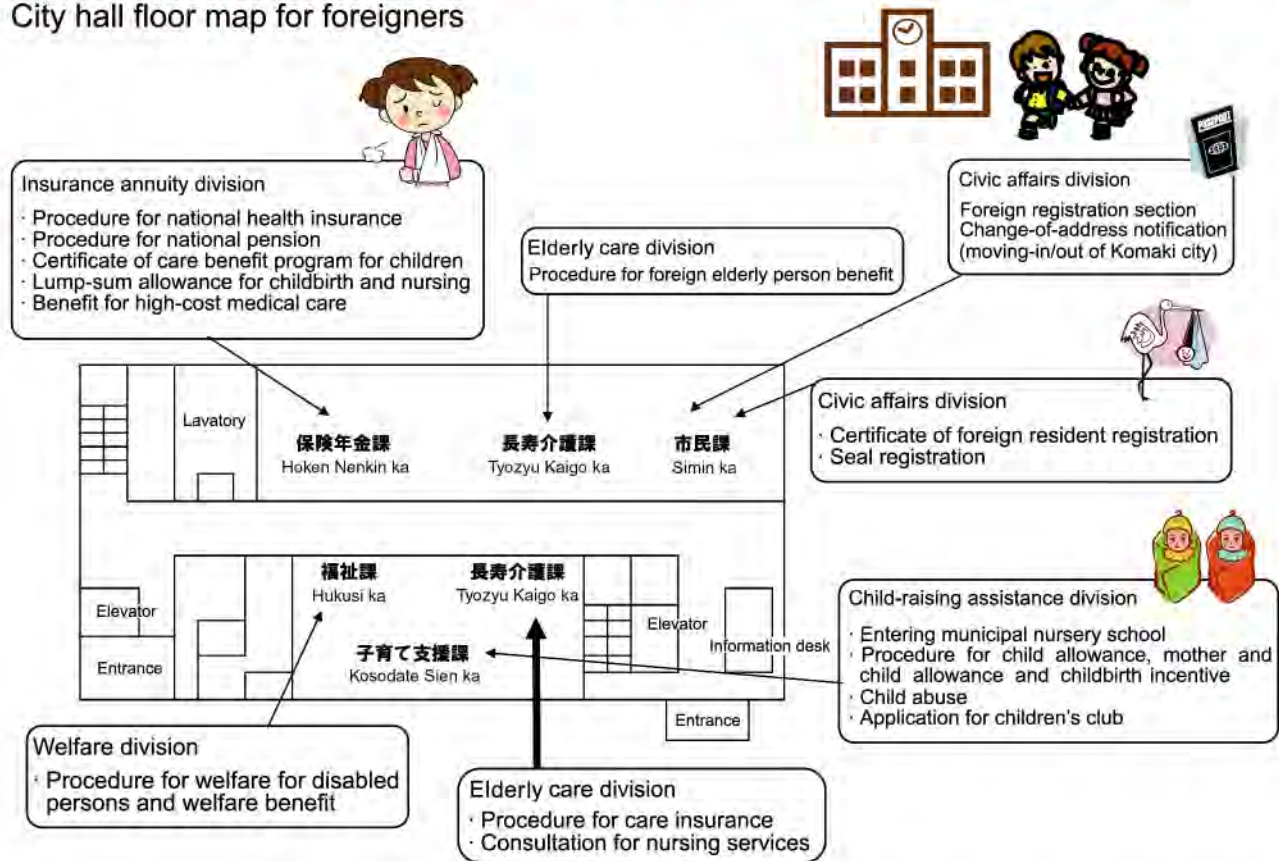

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Komaki City Hall South Building 1F

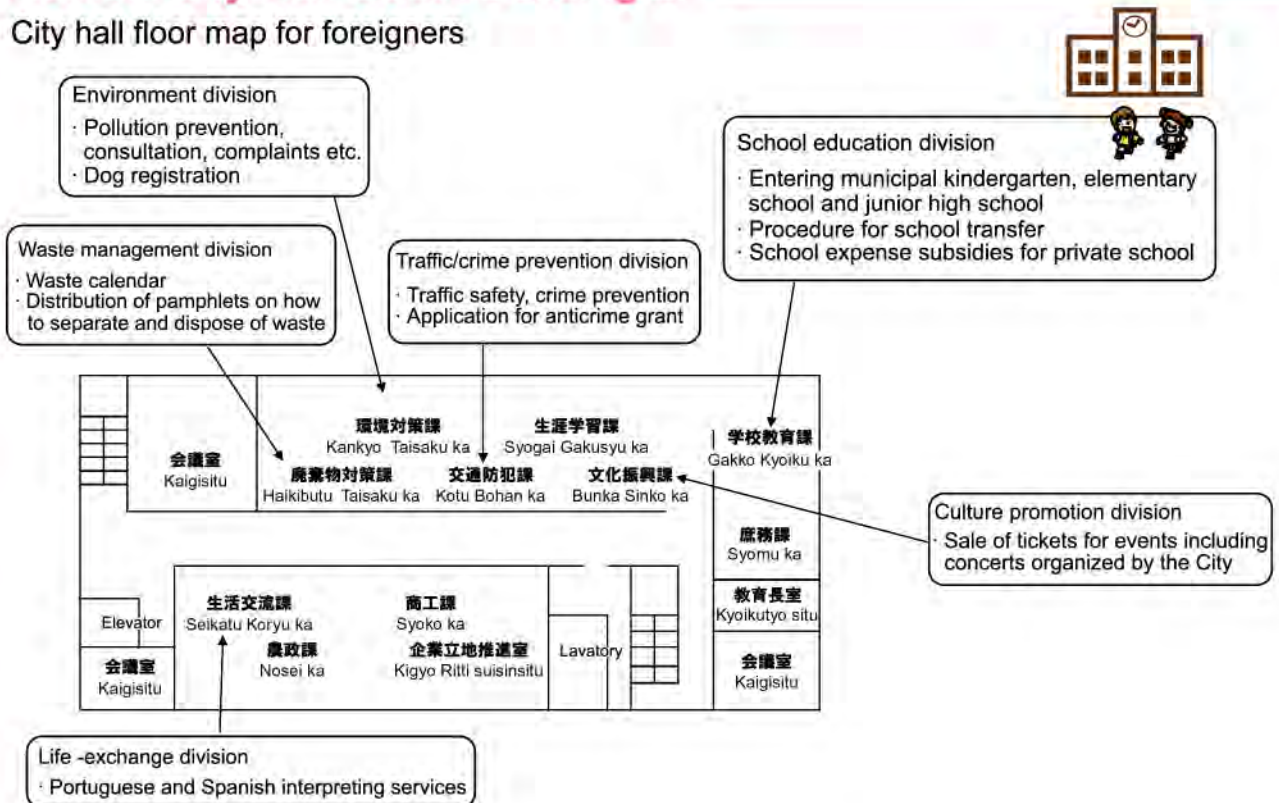
City hall floor map for foreigners

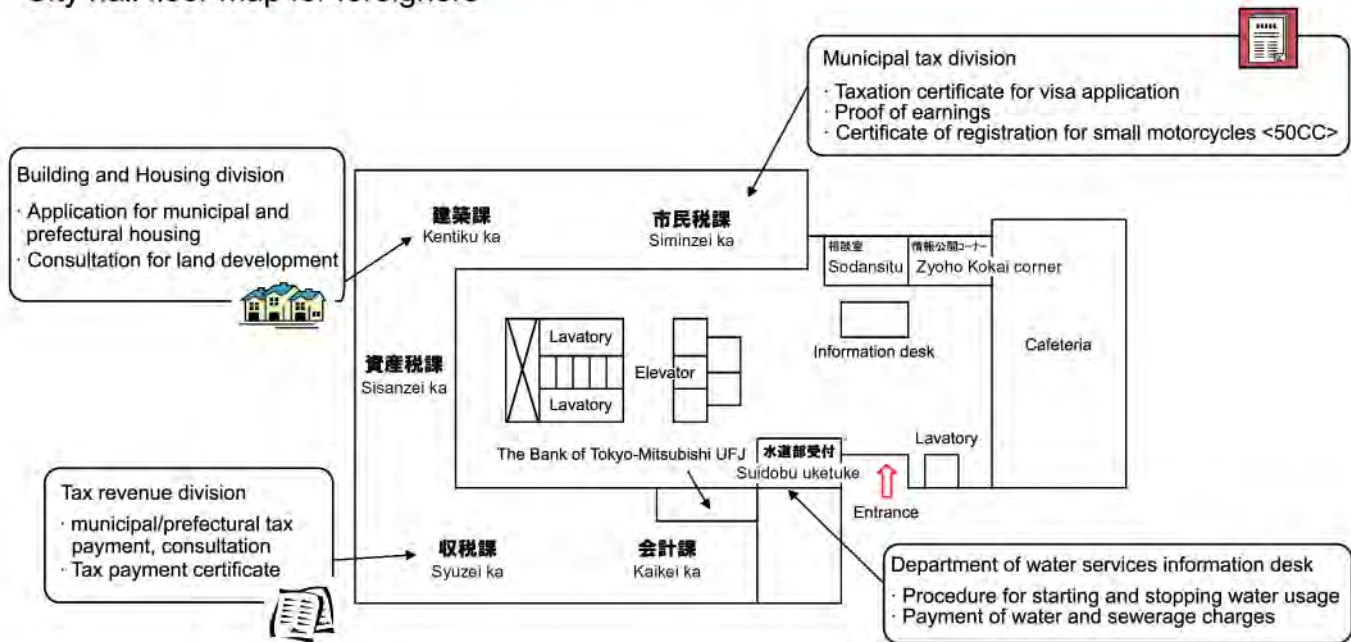

Let's set up a fire alarm!

Due to the increasing of deaths caused by fires, the fire law has changed. From June of 2006, you have to obligatory set up a fire alarm at your residence. Have you already set it up?



You should set it within May 31th, 2008

Be careful ! there are door to door salespersons about them.

What is a fire alarm for residences ?

It's a device which is set up at the ceiling or walls in your residence, and in case of a fire it's automatically activated through sound or voice, let us know in advance that a fire had occurred.

Fire alarms for residences work with batteries and are easy to set. Some types of alarms detects fume and others detects heat. You should set the type of alarms that detects **fume (煙 kemuri)**.

Setting place

① Bedroom

The alarm should be set up in bedrooms (rooms used as bedrooms).

※ The alarms also should be set in the bedrooms of elderly persons or children.

② Stairs

• The alarm should be set up at stairs within access to bedrooms.

※ It is not necessary to set up at the outside stairs.

※ It is not necessary to set up if there is a direct exit to the ground.

• In houses of more than 3 stories, it is required to set up at the stairs of two floors under the bedrooms.

※ It is not necessary to set up at the outside stairs.

※ If an alarm is set up in the upper floor of the stairs, it is not necessary to set up it.

③ Aisle

It is required to set up in aisles where there are more than 5 bedrooms (area more than 7 m²)

④ Kitchen

Is not obligatory to set up an alarm in the kitchen but we recommend to set it up.



Be aware of the following items

- ① You should set up the alarms within the designated period by the country.
We recommend to put the Fire Department logo (NS 日本消防検定協会)
- ② You should be aware of the door to door salespersons. You can cancel the contract (cooling off).
If you live in a rented house consult with the owner or manager about the setting up.
- ③ If you live in a public apartment (ken ei jutaku) consult with the administrator or person in charge about the setting up.

Have you applied for child allowance yet?



June is a month for reviewing child allowance income. Child allowance will be provided every June, based on individual income for the previous financial year (2007 fiscal year). Please apply for the allowance if you are eligible.

If you have not applied, the allowance will not be provided, even if your income qualifies. Please note that in early June, a present status of child allowance will be mailed to the homes of those who are currently receiving the allowance.

Eligible

Those who did not receive child allowance in fiscal 2007 (for the period between June 2007 and May 2008, determined on the basis of income for fiscal 2006).

Submission / contact

Provide necessary information via the appropriate application form (available at the child-raising assistance division, civic centers & city centers in Tobu / Ajioka / Kitazato and homepage), and submit the form directly to the child-raising assistance division (TEL: 76-1129) by Friday, May 30.

Public servants must apply at their work place.



Do you know of the childbirth incentive?

The city provides a childbirth incentive to celebrate the birth of each baby and wish for their healthy growth.

Requirements

- ① Having three or more children.
- ② Main residence in Komaki city.
- ③ Registered in the Komaki basic resident register system for more than one consecutive year, or registered in the alien registration system before the eligible child is born.

Amount of incentive

¥200,000 per eligible child

Required items for application

Passbook (except Yucho Bank) in name of applicant, personal seal

Submission/contact

Provide necessary information via the appropriate application form (available at the child-raising assistance division), and submit the form directly to the child-raising assistance division (TEL: 76-1129).
