2017 Coordinated rabies vaccination



Not only dogs that are kept outdoors, but also indoor dogs should receive rabies vaccinations every year.

2017 coordinated rabies vaccination will be operated according to the schedule below.

The vaccination can be administered at a local veterinarian or coordinated rabies vaccination.

Owners of registered dogs will be sent a notification for rabies vaccination at the end of March.

On the day of the vaccination, fill in the questions on the back of the card and bring it with you.

Please notify the city hall of changes to address or owner, or in the event the dog dies.

Fees

3,400 yen per dog (2,850 yen for the rabies vaccination, 550 yen for certification of the vaccination) If the dog is not registered, a separate 3,000 yen registration fee is required.

Remarks

- ●Please ensure the person bringing the dog to the vaccination site is able to control the dog.
- Please ensure safety with collars, leads, muzzles, etc., as appropriate.
- It may be cancelled due to bad weather.

If you are not sure whether the vaccination will be held or not, please ask the Environment Policy Department.

- **Dog owners should understand about their pets to prevent them from causing disturbances with people in their vicinity.

We are currently accepting applications for Temporary Welfare Benefits (For Economic measures).

If you have received the application form (blue envelope) by mail, please follow the application procedures.

Eligibility

Persons who have registered residency in Komaki City as of January 1, 2016 and are exempt from municipal tax for FY2016 (equalization tax). However, the following persons are not eligible.

- OThe primary income earner is subject to taxation
- OPersons receiving livelihood protection

Amount of support

15,000 yen (One time only) per recipient.

How to apply

▶ Postal mail Please return the designated envelope with the application form and all the required documents by postal

mail which should be postmarked June 1, 2017 (Thu) or before.

▶ Applying in person Please bring the application form and all the required documents by June 1, 2017 (Thu) to Conference room

302, City Hall Main Building 3F(9:00 to 17:00 Excludes Sundays, holidays and the year-end/new year period).

Application deadline

June 1, 2017 (Thu) (Postal mail accepted postmarked no later than the deadline)


