


FY2016 Overview of the initial budget



Definitions

《Revenue》


- Municipal tax: Residential taxes on individual and companies, property taxes on land and buildings, etc.
- ●Treasury/Prefectural disbursement: Monies received from national and prefectural government.
- ●Local transfer tax/subsidies: Monies received from national and prefectural government.
- Money transferred: Monies received from municipal savings.
- Miscellaneous revenue: Interest on savings, etc.
- Municipal debts: Money borrowed from the bank.



Definitions

(Expenditures (by purpose))

- Public welfare: Money used for social projects
- Public works: Money used for constructions of roads and waterways
- Education: Money used for elementary and junior high education and cultural purposes
- Administration: Money used for the municipal offices
- Sanitation: Money used for preventing sickness and treating waste
- National debt service: Money used to pay down loans and interest



Definitions

《Expenditures (by category)》

- Personnel: Wages and allowances for employees
- Social assistance: Money for supporting people eligible for welfare or child assistance
- Ocivil architecture: Money for making roads, school, parks, etc.
- Supplies: Money required for operations
- Required expenses: Obligations for the city including personnel, social assistance, and servicing public debt
- Investment expenses: Money spent on buildings, roads and other facilities that will remain beyond the current fiscal period

The general budget is calculated revenue and expenditures excluding special accounts.

The initial general budget for fiscal 2016 is 53,238,000,000 yen, which is about 472,000,000 yen more than the budget last term.

Comparing the municipal budget to a family budget

The city has many sources of revenue and expenses that differ somewhat from a normal household so it doesn't line up exactly, but here is what a monthly balance book might look like if we made the city into a household with an annual income (including allowances) of 5 million yen.

Regarding income

While the base monthly income decreased, the allowances increased. Part-time income and money borrowed from the bank decreased, but since medical fees were necessary, withdrawals from savings increased.

Regarding spending

The total increased from the previous year due to increase of health costs despite of spending on housing construction and repair as well as allowances for children decreased.
