On the Day of the Ox in midsummer, the Japanese have a custom of eating unagi eel for energy and stamina during the hottest part of the year. Unagi eel are readily available in Aichi prefecture, and are packed with beneficial proteins and vitamins.

- Ingredients (serves 4)
- Rice 450g
 Charcoal grilled unagi eel 4
- · Sansho (Japanese pepper) ····· Dash
- [Sauce]
- Tamari sauce 1 and 1/2 tbsp
- Strong soy sauce 1 and 1/2 tsp
 Sugar 2 tbsp
- Japanese sweet rice wine for cooking (Mirin) ----- 1 tbsp
- · Sake ····· 1 tsp

①Cook the rice.

2 Mix and heat the ingredients for the sauce

③Cut the charcoal grilled eel and place over rice. Add sauce and sansho to taste.
