Disposal procedures will become more convenient!

- 1** Small Crushable Wastes smaller than 15cm can be disposed of as Burnable Garbages.



Examples of burnable garbage

Plastics, rubber, leather etc.



*Items which can be rolled or made smaller such as belt can be disposed of as well.

*These items can be still disposed as crushable waste (in red trash bag) as before.

Plastic container with unremovable content.

(Tubes such as Mayonnaise, toothpaste, paint.)



Home medical waste

(Tubes, IV bags, CAPD bag, etc.)



*Return them to the hospital, clinic or pharmacy.

*Inquire Waste Management Division when you cannot find where to dispose.

Cautions

- ① Ceramics, glass, light bulbs or such should be disposed only as crushable waste no matter the size.



- ② Do not put recyclables inside.



*Dispose in separate green bags based on each item categories.

- 2** We'll collect feather quilt waste for free

Acceptable items and how to dispose

Feather quilts contain 50% or more down.

Check the product tag to make sure it is eligible before bringing to the recyclable collection station in the city.

Cautions

- Show the tag of the quilt to the reception of the collection site.
- It can also be disposed of as burnable or big refuse.

3 Pruned branches disposed at the garbage collection place on the day for burnable garbage collection will be collected as recyclable waste

Acceptable items and how to dispose

- ① Branches... Must be 10 cm or less in diameter and up to 60 cm in length, bundle them, tie them firmly and dispose.
- ② Grass and leaves... Make sure to shake off dirt and mud and dispose in transparent bags (no designated bags).



*Branches pruned for business operation or processed lumbers are not accepted.

Cautions

- Make sure to dispose by 8:30am.
The site will be check in the morning whether there are any pruned branches and collect in the afternoon.
- Do no dispose kitchen refuse, papers or other garbage in the transparent bags.
- Do not dispose too much at once so that garbage collection site will not be full.
