SCHOOL ADMISSION GUIDE FOR FOREIGN CHILDREN

Admission Procedures to Japanese Schools

About Elementary and Junior High Schools (shougako, chugako).

Japanese children must attend compulsory education for 6 years of elementary school (from 6 \sim 12 years old) and 3 years of junior high school (from 12 \sim 15 years old).

Foreign children also can attend elementary or junior high school if desired.

Education is very important matter for the future of the children.

Don't you want your child (children) study at the Japanese school and learn customs along with Japanese children?

■ About the academic year in Japan

The academic year in Japan, starts April 1st and ends March 31st.

The grade is determined by the age of the children.

Children who were born between April 2nd and April 1st of the next year, will belong to the same grade.

Children will be admitted in the grade which correspond to their age.

■ About school fees, texts and school lunch charges

School fee and texts are free of charge.

The charge of school lunch and other school materials except the school texts should be paid every month. (Elementary school 5.000 yen and Junior High e school 10.000 yen).

Persons with economic difficulties who can not pay school lunch, etc. can apply for school financial aid. Please consult at City Hall, to Education Division. (Not all persons will receive this aid).

■ About school entrance procedures

- ① Come to the City Hall, Education Division (3 Floor, Main Building) bringing your child residence card and apply for the entrance to elementary or junior high school.
- ② After finishing the procedure, go to the school which your child was admitted.

Note:

- ◆ You can not choose the school. It is determined by your address.
- ◆ The grade is determined by the age of the child

■ If the child does not understand Japanese or does nor know about the Japanese schools system, there is a class they can attend (Nijikko Kyoushitu).

[Nijikko Kyoushitu]

In case the children who are admitted to Municipal elementary or Junior high schools do not understand Japanese, can learn at Nijikko Kyoushitu for approximately 3 months and concentrate to learn daily conversation, hiragana, katakana, Japanese schools rules and customs. (After finishing this class, the children will attend the school who was admitted)
