

Rabies Vaccinations and Participating Veterinary Hospitals

In accordance with the Rabies Prevention Law, owners must have their dogs vaccinated against rabies once every year.

Please have the vaccination administered at a local veterinarian or coordinated rabies vaccination. If vaccination will be administered at a veterinary hospital, you can receive a rabies vaccination card from City Hall. If you go to one of the facilities listed below they will be able to issue the card on site. Owners of registered dogs will be sent a notification for rabies vaccination at the end of March each year. On the day of the vaccination, fill in the questions on the back of the card and bring it with you.

3,300 yen per dog (2,750 yen for the rabies vaccination, 550 yen for certification of the vaccination) *To find out about the vaccination fees at animal hospitals, please contact the facility directly. If the dog is not registered, a separate 3,000 yen registration fee is required.

Remarks

Please ensure the person bringing the dog to the vaccination site is able to control the dog. Please ensure safety with collars, leads, muzzles, etc., as appropriate. Annual rabies vaccination is required by law for dogs regardless of whether they are kept indoors or outdoors.



The Tokadai Bus Stop has highway bus connections to the Sakae Meitetsu Bus Center and Tajimi/Kani as well as towards Nagano and Tokyo, with 171 busses passing through every weekday.


