<When you run non-registered childcare facilities</p> or non-registered home-visit childcare business.>

It has been...

Mandatory to register when you take care of 6 or more babies (0 – 6 year old children) a day.

From April 1st, 2016

It is mandatory to register when you take care of 1 or more babies (0 – 6 year old children) a day. *Although, in case when you take care of babies temporary, you do not need to register.



★Private Baby-sitter

- ⇒ Prefecture you live. (Aichi if you live in Komaki city.)
- ★Baby-sit business owner ⇒ Prefecture of where your office exists. (Aichi if the office is in Komaki city.)

<Participate in training periodically!>

Non-registered home-visit childcare businesses (baby-sitters) or non-registered childcare facilities which take care of five or fewer babies (0 – 6 year old children) a day, must report where, when and how many times you have participated in courses. **To participate in courses, consult the prefecture (Aichi if Komaki city) government.

(Example courses: Home-visit childcare training, Childcare supporter training)

Komaki Junkai Bus routes will be more convenient!

Komaki Junkai Bus will be more convenient all over Komaki city from April, 2016.

From April 1

- 18 buses are going to cover total 19 courses in the city.
- All courses in the city will be served once per hour.
- Bus stops will be available within a 500-meter radius from where ever you live.

(*Bus stops for civil fixed-route buses are included.)







Komaki Junkai Bus is a Green bus, with an Orange brand logo mark.

Offering free service!

All courses will be served for free on April 2 (Sat) and 3 (Sun)!

On the two days above, anyone can ride Komaki Junkai Bus for free.

Changes from April 1, 2016

We are going to stop current 4 courses which are course 4 5 7 and 8 and start 10 new courses (courses 16 - 19 and 55 - 60).

Compact low-floor buses will run for course 16 17 18 and 19. You can access from Hokubu and Tobu to the center of Komaki which is Komaki Station, City Hall or Civic Hospital using these courses.

Minivan buses are going to run service at course 55 56 57 58 59 and 60.

You can access from Hokubu to Ajioka Station and Tagatajinja-mae Station, and from Tobu to Tokadai Center. It will be able to transfer to course 16 17 18 and 19 at Ajioka Station, Kinro Center and Tokadai Center bus stop.

Routes, bus stops and schedule will partially change in other courses as well. Please check the table on the right for more details.

New minivan buses are in service

Since we are going to start new bus courses, there are not enough buses. That is why we decided to add 3 more new minivan buses (for 10 people). They will run the service on one of the busier courses (5) to (6). You can ride on these 3 new buses even when you are on a wheelchair. (*one wheelchair per car.) When somebody is riding with a wheelchair, the rest of the capacity is up to 6 people.





The new course map and schedule after Apr 1, 2016, are distributed at public facilities such as City Hall, each branch offices and Komaki Station Branch Office, and also inside the buses. We also have smaller schedule. We can deliver to your house via mail.
