The Japanese Meteorological Agency (JMA) issues warnings to call for caution when major disaster is likely to strike, including heavy rains, earthquakes, tsunami, and high tide. Additionally, when rainfall, tsunami waves or other natural phenomenon is considered likely to exceed the standard for issuing warnings and the danger of large scale disaster is increased, an

Emergency Warning is issued to call for caution. In the event of an Emergency Warning, understand that the area you live in is facing a danger such as might occur once in a decade. Pay attention to information such as your surroundings or instructions to evacuate issued by the City and take immediate action to save lives.


