## Sorting/setting out recyclables and garbage

Komaki has specific rules for separating recyclables and garbage. Keep the following points in mind when setting out your recyclables and garbage



Always dispose of recyclables and garbage in designated Komaki City garbage bags

Use white bags for burnable garbage.



Use red bags for non-burnable garbage.



Use green bags for recyclables.



In the aftermath of the March 2011 major earthquake in northeast Japan, the power of community played an important role in many aspects of the response.
