Juki Net covers foreign residents as well

Starting July 8, 2013, as foreign residents will be included in Juki Net *, a Resident Registration Code * will be added to the resident registrar and Juki Cards ** will be issued to foreign residents. A notice of your Resident Registration Code (shown below) will be sent to the head of the household from Komaki City Hall after July 8.

XJuki Net: A nation-wide system for identifying persons.

*Resident Registration Code: A unique 11-digit number used nation-wide as needed to identify persons.

%Juki Card: A public identification certificate with a photograph.

If your household has low income, you may apply to have your national health insurance premiums lowered. (This is called an application for exemption.) In particular, persons under 30 years of age can apply with only their income at the Health Insurance and Pension Department.

 \gtrsim You can apply back to July 2012 if you apply before the end of July 2013.



*Persons that have applied for exemptions or deferrals in the past that were approved must apply for renewal each year after July.

What about National Pension? * * * * * * * * * *

The laws of Japan specify that foreign nationals living in Japan (aged 20 to 59) [must enroll in national pension and pay the premiums.

There are three kinds of national pension.

Basic pension for the elderly * * * * * * *

People that have paid national pension premiums for at least 25 years (or had approved exemptions) can apply to receive benefits from 65 years old.

Basic disability pension * * * * * * * * * * * *

During enrollment in national pension, persons determined to have a level 1 or 2 disability due to sickness or injury can receive benefits upon approval of their application.

Basic survivor pension * * * * * * * * * * * *

Survivors of persons that die during enrollment in national pension can receive benefits upon approval of their application.

%Lump sum withdrawal

Foreign nationals that have paid 6 months or more worth of national pension premiums may apply for a lump sum withdrawal within two years of leaving Japan. Please apply at City Hall before leaving Japan.

You will be provided with an application form.

Oda Nobunaga built the castle on Mt. Komaki, but only resided there for four years. Nobunaga, having achieved his goal of subduing Mino, moved soon thereafter from Mt. Komaki Castle to Gifu Castle. Although many said this left Mt. Komaki Castle as a simple fortress for attacking Mino, recent excavation and research has shown the castle was built on a great stone wall.

To prevent illegal dumping, it is important that all citizens dispose of unneeded appliances and furniture according to the rules.

Persons disposing of garbage and other waste illegally may be subject to a jail term of up to 5 years or a fine of up to 10,000,000 yen or a combined sentence according to the law.
