# Overview of the initial budget for fiscal 2019

The general budget is the core budget, covering revenue and expenditures excluding special budgets. The initial general budget for fiscal 2019 is 54,752,000,000 yen, which is about 2,704,000,000 yen less than the budget last term.

#### Comparing the municipal budget to a family budget

The city has many sources of revenue and expenses that differ somewhat from a normal household so it doesn't line up exactly, but here is what a monthly balance book might look like if we made the city into a household with an annual income (including allowances) of 5 million yen.

While the base monthly income and the allowances increased, part-time income decreased. Withdrawals from savings and bank loan decreased with reduced spending on support for reconstruction of the relative's house and our own housing constructions and repairs.






