



**COVID-19 vaccine immunization in Komaki City**

<b>Vaccination age range</b>	12 years old or older	<b>Number of shots</b>	2 times
<b>Fee</b>	0 yen	<b>Time between vaccinations</b>	Pfizer : 21 days Takeda/Moderna : 28 days
<b>Venue</b>	<p>Group immunization site (Komaki Civic Hall, Tobu Community Center, City Hall, Municipal Hospital, etc.) or local medical institution</p> <p>* Takeda/Moderna vaccine only is applied at the Nagoya airport terminal.</p> <p>* When being vaccination by your workplace, ask your employer.</p>		
<b>How to receive your vaccination</b>	<p><b>Persons born on or after April 2, 1965 will not be able to make a reservation without vaccine coupon and the "Notice of start accepting reservations (by age)".</b></p> <p>Make an appointment by (1) LINE (2) internet or (3) phone (0120-97-5727). City hall is not accepting reservation. For details about vaccination methods and sites, please see the pamphlet in the vaccination coupon or the city website.</p>		
<b>What to bring</b>	<p>Vaccination coupon, questionnaire*, identification (My Number Card, Zairyu Card, Driver's License, Health Insurance Certificate, etc.)</p> <p>* Foreign language questionnaires are available on the government website or at group immunization sites.</p>		
<b>Request</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Wear clothes that make it easy to access the upper arm (such as a T-shirt).</li> <li>• Wear a mask.</li> <li>• After vaccination, please wait 15 to 30 minutes for observation before going home.</li> <li>• People taking medicines should bring their medicine handbook or other means to identify medicines and treatments they are receiving.</li> <li>• <b>If you are currently undergoing treatment for a disease or have concerns about your health condition, please consult with your family doctor before deciding whether or not to receive the vaccine.</b></li> </ul>		
<b>About cancellation</b>	<p>To avoid wasting of this important vaccine, in case you cannot come on the booked day, please be sure to contact Call center (0120-97-5727).</p>		

## FAQ

### Am I obligated to receive the COVID-19 vaccine?

There is no need for you to feel forced to receive the vaccine if you do not want it.

### What are the side effects?

Some people experience hardness, pain, itchiness, swelling or redness in the place they received the shot. Rarely, people may feel fatigue, fever or joint and muscle pain.

### Is there any compensation in case a side effect occurs?

When you receive the vaccine, becoming ill or residual disability are extremely rare. In this case, based on the vaccination law, you may be eligible to have medical expenses covered or disability pension.

### When do I make the appointment for the second shot?

When you make your appointment for your first shot, make you reservation for the second shot as well.

### What should I do to receive a vaccine somewhere other than Komaki City?

- Persons receiving a vaccine at medical institutions or facilities while receiving inpatient care : with the medical institution or facility.
- Persons receiving a vaccine at medical institutions as part of care for an underlying condition : Consult with the medical institution.
- Persons not living at their registered domicile : It may be possible to receive a vaccine where you are actually living. Inquire at your local municipal office.

### Did you already get the vaccine passport?

“Vaccine Passports” are documentation that certifies who have received inoculation for COVID-19. In case of traveling you can apply for the vaccine passport issued by Komaki city.

Apply (1) online, (2) by postal mail, or (3) at the service counter. Check for details in the city homepage.
