House Fire Prevention

It is important to prevent fires daily.

Check the 7 points written below and be diligent for fire prevention.

House Fire Prevention 7 points to save your life.

(Reference: Fire and Disaster Management Agency Website)

1 Set smoke detectors to prevent delayed evacuation.

Use fire-proofed items to prevent the fire from beds, blankets, clothes and curtains.



3 Set fire extinguishers to extinguish the fire while it's small.



Organize a cooperating system in your neighborhood to protect elder and physically handicapped people.



5 Never smoke in bed.




6 Use heaters away from burnable items.



7 Always turn off the gas stove when leaving the place.

How to use electrical appliances daily guideline.

Do not overload electrical circuits.
 (See the picture of multi connection on the right)



- Do not pull the cord forcibly to disconnect a plug.
- 3 Disconnect a plug from the outlet when it is not used.
- Clean dust and rust off the plug regularly to prevent tracking phenomenon.

What is Tracking?

Tracking is fire breaking out caused by a spark out of accumulated dust and collected moisture on a plug left on the outlet. (Photo is excerpted from Tokyo Fire Department Website)

Please install smoke detectors

Due to the recent increase of fatalities caused by residential fires, all residents are now required to

install smoke detectors in houses, apartments and condominiums.

Detects the heat and smoke caused by a fire and warns

about the outbreak of a fire with a buzzer or recorded voice.





Ceiling type Wall type

Required places to install

- **Bedroom**: Install in rooms you sleep!
- Staircase: Install in staircases connected
 - to the floor where bedroom is!
- **Kitchen:** Not required but recommended!

Avoid letting clothes catch on fire!

Be careful to not let your clothes catch fire.

This is a common fire accident, and some casualties have occurred in Komaki due to clothes catch fire.

If the clothes you were wearing catch fire, roll on the ground to extinguish them. If there is drawn water such as in a bathtub, throw water to extinguish the fire. *Always get medical attention after putting out the fire.

What to do when fire breaks out.

In case of fire, calm down and perform the 3 steps described below.

First responder fire fighting

Report

- 1 Report as soon as possible
- Shout "Kajida (Fire)" as loud as possible and tell the neighbors.
- **○Call 119.**

Extinguish the fire

- 2 Extinguish as soon as possible
- Extinguish the fire calmly using the fire extinguisher.

Evacuation

- 3 Evacuate as soon as possible
- Oln case of interior fire, stop fighting the fire and run away if the fire reaches the ceiling.
- Ocover your mouth and nose, and keep yourself as low as possible when evacuating in smoke.

How to use fire extinguishers

1) Pull off the 2) Take the hose and point at the fire. safety pin.

(3) Grip the lever tight.







Use the fire extinguishers on the street!

Public fire extinguishers are installed on the street for first responder firefighting use.

National Pension for all persons from 20 years old

National Pension is a system to provide a basic pension to ensure livelihood after becoming elderly or in case of some unfortunate occurrence. In order to provide this service all persons living in Japan between ages 20 and 60 are required to pay national pension premiums (basic pension) regardless of occupation. After the 20th birthday, an application form and payment slip will be sent by the Japan Pension Service. If payment of premiums is difficult, persons under 50 years of age can use the payment deferment system and students can use the student payment special deferment system. Please contact below for more details.

- 1. Support when you become elderly. Basic pension for the elderly
- 2. Support when you have disability due to sickness or injure. Basic disability pension
