- Late-Term Medical Insurance for the Elderly (8th term)



Avoid missed payments by setting up direct debit payments from your bank account. If you have already set up direct debit payments for your taxes, be sure that your account has sufficient funds available by the day before payment is due. Payments for Municipal Tax etc., are available on the Smartphone App, PayB. Please check PayB website (<https://payb.jp>) for more information.

If you are too busy during the day on weekdays to make your payment...

A tax payment service counter will be open every Sunday. (Except year end/New Years)

① The main building's second floor will be open to answer tax-payment related questions.

② The main building's first floor will be open to pay taxes.

You can consult about status of residence with the staff of the Nagoya Regional Immigration Bureau ("Nagoya Nyukan"). Consultation is available every first Wednesday. When the first Wednesday is a holiday, the consultation day changes. (May 6 (Thu) and Nov 4 (Thu))




Human Rights Protections for COVID-19

Purpose


This ordinance prevents actions including bias towards persons related to COVID-19 infections and defines responsibilities for the city, citizens and businesses.
