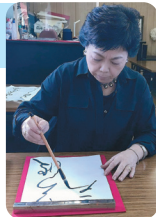

COVID-19 vaccination information

Vaccination ticket issuance period

Tickets were sent from April in order of age to persons of 85 years old or over. Tickets will be sent to other persons in order of age based on the amount of vaccine that has been delivered to the city. When you receive your vaccination ticket, make a reservation by LINE, internet or phone.

Request at the time of vaccination

- Wear clothes that will make it easy to receive vaccination. (T-shirt or other clothes that make it easy to access the upper arm) ●After being vaccinated, you will need to wait for 15 to 30 minutes at the venue.
 ●Please wear a mask when you come.

What to bring

Vaccination ticket, questionnaires, identification documents (zairyu card, driver's license, health certificate, individual number card, etc.)

Other

- Persons receiving treatment for existing illness and persons worried about their physical health should consult with their physician in advance to confirm whether they are eligible for vaccination before making an appointment. ●Foreign language edition questionnaires are available on the Komaki City website. You can print and use it. If you would like one sent by mail, please call us.

at senior care living facilities, etc.

- The vaccine requires two shots.
- After completing the first vaccination, about three weeks is required until the second vaccination.
- At the group immunization venue, we are receiving cooperation from physicians, nurses and pharmacists in addition to the medical facilities that can perform individual immunizations.
- Weekday vaccination at the civic hall are being handled by Komaki Daiichi Hospital.

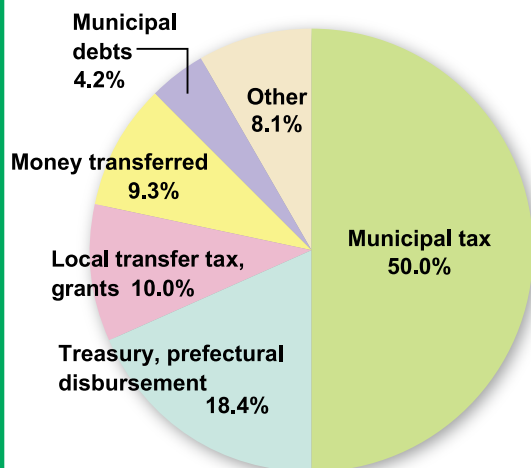
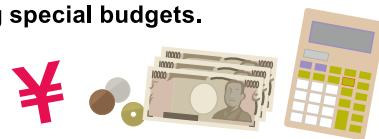

The general budget is the core budget, covering revenue and expenditures excluding special budgets.

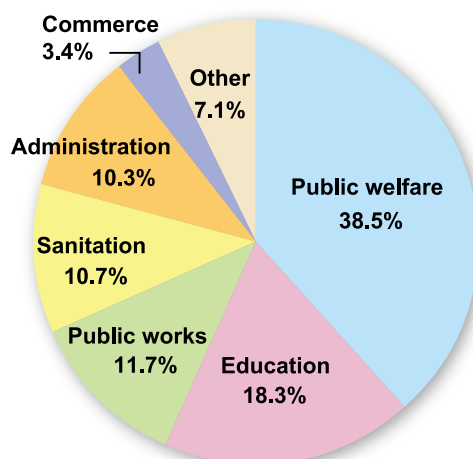
The initial general budget for fiscal 2021 is 59,063,000,000 yen,
which is about 2,513,000,000 yen less than the budget last term.

Definitions 《Revenue》

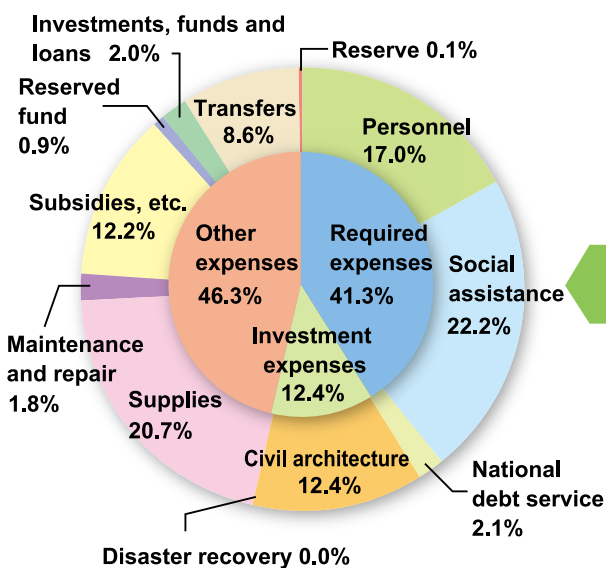
- **Municipal tax...**Residential taxes on individual and companies, property taxes on land and buildings, etc.
- **Treasury, prefectural disbursement...**Monies received from the country and prefecture
- **Money transferred...**Monies received from municipal savings
- **Local transfer tax, grants...**Monies received from the country and prefecture
- **Municipal debts...**Monies borrowed from banks

Definitions 《Expenditures (by purpose)》

- **Public welfare...**Monies used for social projects
- **Education...**Money used for elementary and junior high education and cultural purposes
- **Public works...**Monies used for road or river works
- **Sanitation...**Money used for preventing sickness and treating waste
- **Administration...**Money used for the municipal offices
- **Commerce...**Monies used for the support for corporates or for festivals

Definitions 《Expenditures (by category)》

- **Personnel...**Wages and allowances for employees
- **Social assistance...**Monies for supporting people eligible for welfare or child assistance
- **Civil architecture...**Monies for making roads, school, parks, etc.
- **Supplies...**Money required for operations
- **Required expenses...**Obligations for the city including personnel, social assistance, and servicing public debt
- **Investment expenses...**Monies spent on buildings, roads and other facilities that will remain beyond the current fiscal period

► Comparing the municipal budget to a family budget

The city has many sources of revenue and expenses that differ somewhat from a normal household so it doesn't line up exactly, but here is what a monthly balance book might look like if we made the city into a household with an annual income (including allowances) of 5 million yen.

* The value in parentheses is the difference from the budget revision from last year.

Income

While part-time income increased, the base monthly income and the allowances decreased. Withdrawals from savings and bank loan decreased due to reduced spending on own housing constructions and repairs.

**What you can do
as an individual
or family**



- 1 Check locations with danger in your home, school, company and transit routes using the disaster prevention guidebook, and consider two or more safe routes.
- 2 Choose an evacuation destination for family and closely related persons (meeting place)!
- 3 Learn how to use the disaster prevention information email and disaster communication hotlines.
- 4 Prepare emergency portable goods and emergency supplies.

In Komaki City, there is a service for sending disaster prevention information by email to cell phones and computers. Information is gathered to help you take correct action when something occurs.



Komaki Disaster Prevention Information E-Mail Delivery Service

This service will provide information regarding to disasters such as earthquake, heavy rain, storm or missile launch via e-mail (mobile/PC).



Registration Method
