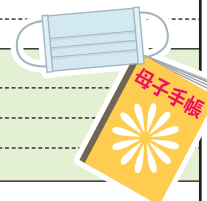

Pay promptly!

- Normally Collected Municipal and Prefectural Tax (4th Term)
- National Health Insurance Tax (8th term)
- Nursing Care Insurance Fees (7th term)
- Late-Term Medical Insurance for the Elderly (6th term)

Avoid missed payments by setting up direct debit payments from your bank account. If you have already set up direct debit payments for your taxes, be sure that your account has sufficient funds available by the day before payment is due. Payments for Municipal Tax etc., are available on the Smartphone App, PayB, PayPay and LINEPay. *Persons using direct deposit to account cannot use payment by app. Instructions are available on the website of the relevant website.



When you are unable to pay by the predetermined date due to decreased wages or other reason, consult with the tax collection division.

If the deadline passes, you will need to pay arrears (penalty for late payment).

If you are too busy during the day on weekdays to make your payment...

A tax payment service counter will be open every Sunday. (Except year end/New Years)

① The main building's second floor will be open to answer tax-payment related questions. Payments are accepted as well.

Hours: Jan 9 (Sun) and Jan 23 (Sun) 8:30 to 17:15

② The main building's first floor will be open to pay taxes.

Hours: Jan 9 (Sun), 16 (Sun), 23 (Sun) 8:30 to 17:15

③ You can pay payment slips with bar codes at convenience stores.

Payment notices will be sent by January 17 (Mon) to confirm the amount paid from January 1 to December 31, for 2021 national health insurance, nursing insurance and late term medical insurance for the elderly.

National Pension for all persons from 20 years old



The National Pension is a system that ensures the livelihood of citizens with a pension after becoming elderly or in case of some unfortunate occurrence. All persons living in Japan between ages 20 and 59 are required to pay national pension premiums (basic pension) regardless of occupation. After the 20th birthday, the pension handbook and payment slips will be sent by the Japan Pension Service. If payment of premiums is difficult, persons under 49 years of age and students can use the payment deferment system or the student payment special deferment system. Please contact us for more details.
