Avoid missed payments by setting up direct debit payments from your bank account. If you have already set up direct debit payments for your taxes, be sure that your account has sufficient funds available by the day before payment is due. You can pay taxes using smartphone apps including PayB or PayPay.

\* Persons using direct deposit to account cannot use payment by app. Instructions are available on the website of the app.



When you are unable to pay by the predetermined date due to decreased wages or other reason, consult with the taxation division. If the deadline passes, you will need to pay arrears (penalty for late payment).

## Notification of the Current Status of Welfare Allowance

The following persons are required to submit a current status report or income status report every year. You will be sent a current status or income status form on Jul 31 (Thu). Fill out required items and submit it with the required documents. Complete these procedures promptly.

### Eligibility

Persons receiving special disability allowance, welfare allowance for disabled children, transitional welfare allowance, special child support allowance, home severe disability allowance or Komaki City mental and physical disability assistance fee

### Application Period

Komaki City Aid for the Mentally and Physically Disabled: Aug 1 (Fri) to Aug 19 (Tue)

Home Severe Disability Allowance: Aug 1 (Fri) to Aug 29 (Fri)

Special child support allowance, special disability allowance, welfare allowance for disabled children, and transitional welfare allowance: Aug 12 (Tue) to Sep 11 (Thu)

### Other

- ▶ If you have applied for the home severe disability allowance and moved into Komaki City after January 2, 2025, obtain an income tax certificate for the fiscal year 2025 (for income during 2024) from the municipality in which you registered your address on January 1, 2025 and submit it together with the application. (For more information, contact the Disability and Welfare Division.)
- ▶ If you do not submit the notification on current status or other documents, you will not receive the allowance even if you meet the requirements. Make sure to complete the procedures before the deadline.

## Temporary Benefits as Part of Comprehensive Economic Measures

The price of food and other commodities is rising, so you can receive a temporary benefit to support your life and livelihood.

### Eligibility

Persons who meet ① below and either ② or ③

- ① Persons living in Komaki as of January 1, 2025
- ② Persons for whom the amount of benefits from the fixed tax reduction implemented in FY2024 is insufficient to cover the shortfall of the fixed tax reduction determined by the end of December 2024.
- ③ Persons whose income tax for 2024 and resident tax income rate for 2024 is 0 yen and whose full-time employee or income amount is higher than 480,000 yen.

\* Persons exempt from household taxes due to tax agreements are not included.



### Amount of support

Dependents on income and number of dependents.

The city sent the documents to those considered eligible **in July**. Postcards are for those who have received benefits in Komaki City after January 2024.

Others use an application form (green envelope).

If you believe you are eligible but have not received your documents, please contact the call center.

### Application procedures

If you received a postcard

Check if the account information is correct.  
Transfer the benefits as indicated on the postcard.

If you received an application form (green paper)

When the application form arrives, check the content thereof and fill in the required information before sending it back to the City Hall.

The form must be received by **October 31, 2025**.

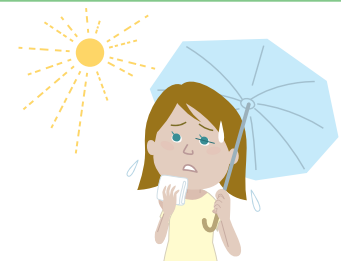
If you do not send your application to the city during the application period, you will not receive benefits.

## Beware of heat stroke

- ▶ Heat stroke is what happens when your body loses sufficient water and retains heat from exposure to high temperatures over a long time.
- ▶ Heat stroke can be deadly, but it is preventable.



- ① One can easily have a heat stroke when the temperature and humidity are high, the wind is low, and the sunlight is strong or even in a room without air conditioning. Small children, elderly, obese people or people with an illness should take special care.
- ② Take special care on days when the news warns about heat stroke. To prevent heat stroke, drink lots of water, use a parasol or hat, stay in the shade or use air conditioning. It is also important to rest when you feel unwell.

Beware of sales pitches like this

Inspection business

They may offer to inspect your roof for free, and after the inspection, they may recommend repairs that are not necessary. Enter contracts with care.

Online shopping

When you buy something online, check whether there is a requirement for a regular subscription? Check the terms and conditions of the contract before applying.

\*Subscription: Continuously buying the same product at regular intervals.



Points to keep in mind when applying and making payments

► Be sure to check the contract and terms of use when applying.

\*Terms of Use: Rules to follow when using services, etc.

► Credit card installment payments (revolving payments, etc.) incur interest, so only use them for planned purchases.

► Personal information should not be easily shared with others. Be careful with your identification cards to avoid misuse.
