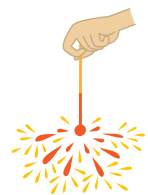

Submit your payments promptly!

Avoid missed payments by setting up direct debit payments from your bank account.

If you have already set up direct debit payments for your taxes, be sure that your account has sufficient funds available by the day before payment is due.

You can pay taxes using smartphone apps including PayB or PayPay.

* Persons using direct deposit to account cannot use payment by app.

Instructions are available on the website of the app.



When you are unable to pay by the predetermined date due to decreased wages or other reason, consult with the taxation division.

If the deadline passes, you will need to pay arrears (penalty for late payment).

If you are too busy during the day on weekdays to make your payment...

You can pay at a tax payment service counter open on Sunday.

(Except year end/New Years)

Evacuation centers tend to be crowded, with little privacy and sometimes not enough space. Let's be prepared so that we can choose to shelter in place if necessary.

Securing your furniture ▶ Take these steps in advance to protect your life and the lives of your family.

Avoid blocking doorways ▶ Tidy up any belongings in your entrance and hallways so that people can pass through.

It's important to keep a rolling stock in your pantry ▶ Be sure to have enough food and water for at least three days. Be sure to keep extra toilet paper, diapers, and other items on hand at home.

Preparing a portable toilet ▶ Since the restroom may be unavailable at times, prepare for three days of use.

Notification of the Current Status of Welfare Allowance

The following persons are required to submit a current status report (income status notice) report every year. You will be sent a current status (income status notice) form on Jul 31 (Fri). Fill out required items and submit it with the required documents. Complete these procedures promptly.

Eligibility

Special disability allowance, welfare allowance for children with disabilities, transitional welfare allowance, special child support allowance, and allowance for severely disabled persons living at home, Persons receiving Komaki City aid for the mentally and physically disabled

Application Period

Komaki City Aid for the Mentally and Physically Disabled: **Aug 3 (Mon) to Aug 19 (Wed)**

Home Severe Disability Allowance: **Aug 3 (Mon) to Aug 31 (Mon)**

Special child support allowance, special disability allowance, welfare allowance for children with disabilities, and transitional welfare Allowance: **Aug 12 (Wed) to Sep 11 (Fri)**

Other

- ▶ If you have applied for the home severe disability allowance and moved into Komaki City after January 2, 2026, obtain an income tax certificate for the fiscal year 2026 (for income during 2025) from the municipality in which you registered your address on January 1, 2026 and submit it together with the application. (For more information, contact the Disability and Welfare Division.)
- ▶ If you do not submit the notification on current status or other documents, you will not receive the allowance even if you meet the requirements. Make sure to complete the procedures before the deadline.

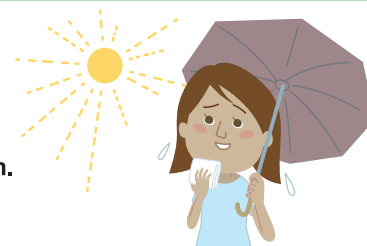

Beware of heat stroke

- Heat stroke is what happens when your body retains heat from exposure to high temperatures over a long time and your body loses sufficient hydration.
- Heat stroke can be deadly, but it is preventable.



- ① One can easily have a heat stroke when the temperature and humidity are high, the wind is low, and the sunlight is strong or even in a room without air conditioning. Small children, elderly, obese people or people with an illness should take special care.
- ② Take special care on days when the news warns about heat stroke.
To prevent heat stroke, drink lots of water, use a parasol or hat, stay in the shade or use air conditioning. It is also important to rest when you feel unwell.

There are places where you can cool off when it's hot

To help residents protect themselves from the heat, Komaki City is providing places to cool off.

① Cooling Spot (COOLPLACE)

These are places where you can pop in to cool off while out and about on a hot day.

With the cooperation of public facilities such as city halls and libraries, as well as private businesses, we are making pharmacies and supermarkets available as cooling spots.

② Cooling Shelter

A Special Heatstroke Alert is issued when dangerous heat poses a risk to health. When this alert is issued, it is important to avoid going outside; however, if it is difficult to stay in a cool place, please use a cooling shelter.
